



Renegade Miata Club Autocross General Information

- NO SPEEDING AT EVENT OR TOWN OF AYER! 5 MPH LIMIT IN PIT AREA!
- *Competitor Eligibility: Members of the Renegade Miata Club. Drivers must be 18 or older.*
- *Boston BMWCCA, North Country Porsche Club, SCCA members must show membership cards or be invited guest of the Autocross Committee.*
- *Numbers will be assigned at first registration of the season for duration of the season.*
- *Registration 8:00 am - 8:45 am: Competitors, workers, crew, and guests must report to Registration upon arrival and sign the insurance waiver. A valid driver's license and entry fee is required. Car numbers and classes will be assigned. A Tech Safety Inspection form must be filled out.*
- *Tech Inspection 8:30 am - 9:15 am: A car must pass a safety inspection before you can compete. Read the Tech Inspection section to see what you'll need to do.*
- *All cars tech'ed in the morning must be driven as is for the day unless there is a safety issue and it is brought to the attention of a member of the Autocross Committee.*
- *Course Walk only after car has passed Tech. No bikes, skates or scooters... WALKING ONLY*
- *Driver's Meeting 9:45am - 10:00 am: This is mandatory for all. You'll get information about course conditions, run and work order, safety notices, and penalties.*
- *Timed Runs 10:00 am: The goal is to complete 7 timed runs. Fun runs at \$1.00 per run will be available at the end of timed runs if time permits.*
- *No passengers allowed during timed runs except for Instructors*
- *No more than two people in a car during fun runs*
- *No more than two drivers (co-drivers) per car. No dual drivers in same run group*
- *No trucks, SUV'S ,or vans allowed to participate*
- *Refunds will only be given with ten day notification of canceling or if the Autocross committee cancels an event.*

Conditions of Participation

- *All competitors must be 18 or older and must have a valid driver's license*
- *Competitors are required to wear seat belts, closed shoes and a Snell 00 rated helmet*
- *All competitors, workers, crew, and guests must sign the insurance waiver.*
- *Anyone possessing or consuming alcohol or narcotics will be disqualified and asked to leave the venue.*
- *Any driver who drives unsafely at or near the venue or displays unsportsmanlike-like conduct shall be disqualified.*
- *All competitors are required to work the event or be disqualified.*
- *The Autocross Committee has the right to refuse entry at their discretion.*

Tech Inspection Requirements

- *Snell 00 or better helmet is required. A limited number of loaners are available.*
- *Safety belts must be firmly attached.*
- *The battery must be secured.*
- *Tires must NOT have any cord showing.*
- *The brake pedal must be firm, without loss of pressure when down.*
- *The steering must be light with no excessive play. Wheel bearings cannot have excessive play.*
- *Hub caps, trim rings, and wheel covers must be removed for competition, unless they are bolted to the wheel.*
- *All loose items must be removed from the passenger compartment and trunk. This includes floor-mats.*
- *Excessive fluid leaks will not pass inspection.*
- *The car numbers should be prominently displayed on both sides of the car. White shoe polish for marking windows or painter's tape will be available if you don't have your own.*

- Adequate mufflers are required.
- Accelerator pedal must have a return spring and operate freely.

What to Bring to an Event

- A valid driver's license.
- A safety helmet, Snell 00 or better
- Extra air in your tires, + 10lbs
- A good tire pressure gauge
- Clothing appropriate for conditions: shoes, hat, rain gear, sunglasses, etc.
- Folding chair, cooler for lunch snacks and plenty of beverages
- Windex and paper towels
- Small tool kit
- Large trash bag for contents of car in case of rain and to keep belongings together.

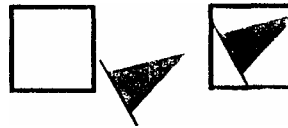
Working Rules and Safety

- Report to work promptly.
- Workers only at stations and on the course! NO SPECTATORS!
- Know your responsibility & station number.
- Understand the pylon and off-course rules.
- Pay attention to cars on course for accurate cone counts and your safety.
- RED flag in hand at all times.
- Know the flagging system.
- Stay alert for unexpected pedestrians and vehicles.
- Do not use cameras while working on course or at stations.
- Do not sit down and do not wander away from your post.
- Red flag a car if there is a safety issue or if instructed to do so.
- Do not litter. Take your trash with you.
- Do not pick up hot parts dropped on course because of risk of burns.

Cones: Down and Out Rule

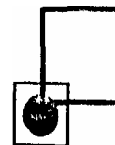
A 2 second penalty is given if:

- A cone is knocked over and out of box.
- A cone is knocked over and in box.
- A cone is standing and out of box.



A penalty is NOT given if:

- The cone is still standing and the base is partially in box.
- Cars passing on wrong side of a gate will be considered "on course" as long as they manage to knock over a cone as they go by the cone/gate.



FAQ: Can I invite a guest to drive at a Renegade autocross?

You must ask the autocross committee ahead of time if you can bring a guest and, if approved, you and your guest must agree that if either of you break any club rules that you both must leave the event.
